



# Refuse Derived Fuel at B&M Waste Services

As a carbon neutral company, B&M Waste Services are always exploring new ways to preserve the Earth's resources for future generations.

One of the ways we are reducing carbon emissions from the waste we collect is processing it at our Refuse Derived Fuel facility at Trafford Park, Manchester.

## How it works

The key objective is to harness energy from waste and therefore enhance our commitment to achieving 'zero landfill'. After separating the waste and removing recyclables, residual waste is compacted into bales and transported to a Combined Heat and Power Facility. Here, energy is harvested to produce electricity and steam which provides thermal heating.

## Why is it good for our customers?

RDF helps our customers to achieve higher than ever recycling levels: we produce environmental reports for each customer so they can demonstrate their own green credentials.

B&M's estimated carbon saving from using RDF is the equivalent to powering 3,350 homes.
